

# Technical & competition information

**Technical & competition information might be subject of variation in according with the judges. In the bid envelope you will find the updated one.**

## Bibs

Bibs displaying the athlete's names may be collected at the *Stadio Quercia* athletes entrance on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> from 5.00 pm. Bib must be worn on the front of the athlete vest (except in the Jumping Events, where bib may be worn on the breast or back only.). Middle distance events competitors will be also provided with bibs displaying numbers that have to be worn on the back of the athlete vest.

All bibs must be in good condition and must not be cut, defaced, folded or altered in any way whatsoever.

The photo-finish numbers will be provided in Call Room.

## Technical Information Center (T.I.C.)

This service is the connection between Clubs, Organization, and Meeting Management, and it acts as the only technical reference point. It is located within the secretariat races under the southern part of the grandstands.

Clubs, athletes, managers, and coaches are invited to contact the TCI for:

- requests for clarification on the regulations and the results;
- forwarding of official complaints, in the second written instance;
- receive a copy of the results of a single event.

## Clothing within the Competition Area

Either for the competition and for prize-giving ceremony athletes have to wear the National or Club/Sponsor gears.

Advertising and displays of a promotional nature on clothing worn within the competition area must fully comply with IAAF Rule 8 and IAAF Regulations in general.

Mobile phones and general electronic devices (i.e. iPod, iPhone) are forbidden from the competition area in according with the current regulations.

## Warm up Area

The warm up area is situated on the north end of the stadium (see attached map). It is a synthetic grass field with a 60 m "Mondotrack-SX" straight track.

## Athletes' Call Room time table

Call Room is located in the north entrance to the track, close to the warm up area (see map).

Call room check-in times:

- |                |                  |

| - Track events | 20' before start |

Please adhere strictly to the above time table.

The actual time of entry into the field is determined by the Director of Meeting. No calls will be made via loudspeaker.

### **Access to and exit from the competition area**

The access to the competition area is strictly controlled from organization's members.

After checking in Call Room, athletes of each event will enter the competition area all together escorted by Officials.

After the event, athletes will exit the competition area through the mix-zone escorted by Officials.

Coaches and Managers are not allowed to enter in the competition area.

### **Throwing Implements**

The official whose responsibility is to check all throwing implements prior to competition will be located next to the Call Room (see attached map).

Competitors are requested to present their implements for approval at least 60 minutes before the commencement of their respective competition.

For personal implements, a receipt will be issued and it will allow for collecting them at the end of the race. The collection point is located under the grandstands in front of the long jump and triple jump sand pits.

Personal implements, if approved, will have to be available to all competitors for the entire duration of the event.

### **Technical standards**

All races take place in series; the series with the best times will be the last.

For throwing and horizontal jumps, all athletes will have three attempts, then the top eight competitors will then be awarded three further attempts.

Progressions in elevation jumps and the triple jump taking-off board distance will be established within the Technical Meeting considering enrollment measures of the participating athletes and it will be communicated by one supplementary note.

### **Starting Procedure**

Athletes will be presented to the stadium spectators and media approximately two minutes before the official starting time of their respective event.

The starter's commands will be carried out in the English language.

### **Complaints**

Complaints about the competition conduct have to be submitted orally to the specific event official within 30 minutes from the results formalization.

In the second instance they can be submitted in writing to the Appeal Jury, accompanied by the prescribed fee of € 100.00 (refundable in case of acceptance). The delivery of the complaints has to be made at the TIC within 30 minutes from the Referee decision.
